



65th Anniversary of the Atomic Mission

Itinerary

Sun Aug 1 Check-in at the Continental Airlines ticket counter at the Honolulu Int'l Airport by 12noon. 3:30pm Depart Honolulu via Continental Airlines #1 non-stop to Guam.

Mon Aug 2 Arrive Guam and connect to Saipan. Meet our local host and transfer to the Pacific Islands Club, Saipan.

Tue Aug 3 Full day tour of Saipan by private coach including Aslito Airfield, Mt. Tapotchau, landing beaches, the American Memorial Park and new Visitor Center & WWII Exhibit, the Japanese Last Command Post, Suicide Cliffs.

Overnight Pacific Islands Club, Saipan.

Wed Aug 4 Check out of the hotel and fly on light aircraft to Tinian with flight seeing of the runways of Tinian enroute. Welcoming reception. Overnight Tinian Dynasty Hotel.

Thu Aug 5 Morning symposium. Afternoon tour of the southern end of Tinian. Evening Bar-b-que fiesta. Overnight Tinian Dynasty Hotel.

Fri Aug 6 Morning ceremony commemorating the 65th Anniversary of the Atomic Mission. Afternoon tour of Tinian's north field. Dinner reception tonight hosted by Mayor of Tinian. Overnight Tinian Dynasty Hotel.

Sat Aug 7 Check out of Dynasty hotel and fly over North Field on our way back to Saipan connecting to a flight to Rota. Visit the Ancient Chamoro Cave Museum with its Japanese and American artifacts from WWII. Or stay at the resort and do a little golfing, bird watching or diving. Overnight Rota Resort & Country Club.

Sun Aug 8 Depart Rota for Guam. Afternoon brief tour of Guam including the War in the Pacific Memorial. Overnight Guam Outrigger Resort.

Mon Aug 9 Early transfer to airport for Continental Airlines #2 at 6:00am, arriving Honolulu 5:05pm Aug 8 (zone line). Tour ends.

Includes round trip economy class air fare from Honolulu to Guam, Saipan, Tinian and Rota; U.S. Departure taxes; travel insurance; services of Prof. Anderson Giles as tour director; seven nights accommodations at hotel indicated; all ground transportation on Saipan, Tinian, Rota and Guam; museum entrance fees and entrance into events; two dinner receptions on Tinian; local guides, drivers and taxes. *Components of tour cannot be purchased separately. Itinerary subject to change. Tour cost based on a minimum of 10 participants.*

Optional extension to Peleliu

Mon Aug 9 All day free on Guam until evening flight to Koror. Overnight Landmark Marina Hotel, Koror.

Tue Aug 10 Morning boat through the Rock Islands to Peleliu. Drop bags at the hotel and tour Peleliu which includes Bloody Nose Ridge, the 81st Infantry monument, Japanese HQ's bunkers, site of the temporary military cemetery, WWII Memorial Museum invasion beaches and the airfield, the strategic objective of the Peleliu campaign. Overnight Island Terrace Hotel.

Wed Aug 11 Visit Angaur by boat.

Thu Aug 12 Return to Koror by boat. Afternoon tour of Koror includes the new National Museum and Cultural Center. Rooms at Landmark Marina Inn until check out around midnight.

Friday Aug 13 Depart Koror for Guam connecting to Honolulu, arriving 5:00pm Aug 12.

Cost for optional Peleliu extension \$1500.00 per person, twin share. Single supplement \$300.00. Includes economy class airfare from/to Guam; four nights hotel accommodations; airport/hotel transfers; round trip boat trip through the Rock Islands; tours in Koror and Peleliu. Cost and escort based on minimum of 6 participants.
