Itinerary (subject to change)

Sat April 3

6:30pm begin check-in at Philippine Airlines counter, San Francisco Int'l Terminal.

10:30pm Depart San Francisco via Philippine Airlines #105, (possible refueling stop in Honolulu or Guam) with dinner and in-flight entertainment.

Sun April 4 - Cross International Date Line and lose this day.

Mon April 5 (D)

5:20am Arrive Manila Int'l Airport. Immigration (passport required), baggage collection and customs. Meet local hosts and board private air-conditioned coach for transfer to the historic Manila Hotel. Visit Mac Arthur Suite and Intramuros, the old walled city. Stop at Tesoro's for shopping on the way back to the hotel. Group dinner and introductions at Club Intramuros and overnight Manila Hotel.

Tue April 6 (B)

Ferry across Manila Bay to Corregidor. Check into hotel and drop luggage. Morning tour in private Tramvia to Bottomside, Middleside and Topside to include Wainwright Park, Army Dock, Navy Dock, Battery Way and Hearn, hospital, gun batteries, Mile Long Barracks, Pacific War Memorial and Museum, Batteries Crockett and Geary, Malinta Tunnel Sound and Light show (subject to permission). Afternoon tour continues with 92nd Garage, Monkey Point and Battery Grubbs for sunset and illumination of Eternal Flame. Flashlight tour of Malinta Tunnel Hospital laterals. Dinner and overnight Corregidor Inn.

Wed April 7 (B, L, D)

Check out of hotel. Ferry to Cabcaben, Bataan. Afternoon free to relax on the South China Sea beach. Overnight Montemar Beach Hotel on the China Sea.

Thu April 8 (B, L, D)

Drive to Kilometer Marker Zero in Mariveles. Tour Bataan with stops at Death March markers as we follow the actual Death March, and Angels of Bataan Marker at Limay. Balanga Elementary School, site of surrender negotiations. Overnight Montemar Beach Hotel.

Fri April 9 (B, L, D)

Check out of hotel and drive to Mt. Samat and the altar of Valor for Anniversary of the fall of Bataan commemorative ceremony with dignitaries that may include President of the Philippines and U.S. and Japanese Ambassadors. Continue to Subic Bay and the Hellships Memorial at Olongapo. Tour Subic area, Jungle Survival Training. Overnight Subic International Hotel.

Sat April 10 (B, L, D)

Check out of hotel and drive to San Fernando Railway Station where the POW's were packed into railroad boxcars for the ride to Capas. Drive to Clark Field to see Fort Stotsenberg gates, Parade Ground, Civilian Cemetery, Clark Field Museum, and Lunch at Clark VFW Canteen. Overnight Clark Holiday Inn.

Sun April 11 (B, L, D)

Drive to Capas Railway Museum, O'Donnell and Battling Bastards of Bataan Memorial.
Overnight La Perilla, Cabanatuan.

Mon April 12 (B, L, D)

Morning visit to American POW Memorial at Cabanatuan, site of former POW camp.
Plenty of time for strolling around and taking group pictures. Return to Manila. Check
into the Manila Hotel.

Tue April 13 (B)

Full day tour including Bilibid Prison (subject to permission), site of Ft. Bonifacio,
American Cemetery at Forbes Park (private wreath laying), site of Nichols Field and Fort
Mc Kinley. Check out in late evening and transfer to airport for PAL
#104 at 10:30pm, arriving San Francisco 6:30pm same day. **Tour ends.**
