Itinerary

- Dec. 8** 3:20pm Depart Honolulu via Continental Airlines. Cross the Int'l Date Line.
- Dec. 9** 7:10pm Arrive Guam. Transfer to Guam Outrigger Hotel for next three nights.
- Dec. 10** Full day tour of Guam, War in the Pacific Memorial and Anderson Andersen AFB subject to permission. Banquet/briefing tonight at Guam Outrigger.
- Dec. 11** Early transfer to airport for chartered flight to Wake Island w/breakfast served in-flight. Upon arrival in Wake, briefing, commemorative ceremony at Memorial site, box lunch, remainder of day free for self-exploration. Fly back to Guam this evening. Transfer to hotel.
- Dec. 12** Transfer to airport. 6:40am Depart Guam via Continental Airlines, arriving Honolulu on Dec 11 at 5:50pm after recrossing Date Line.
