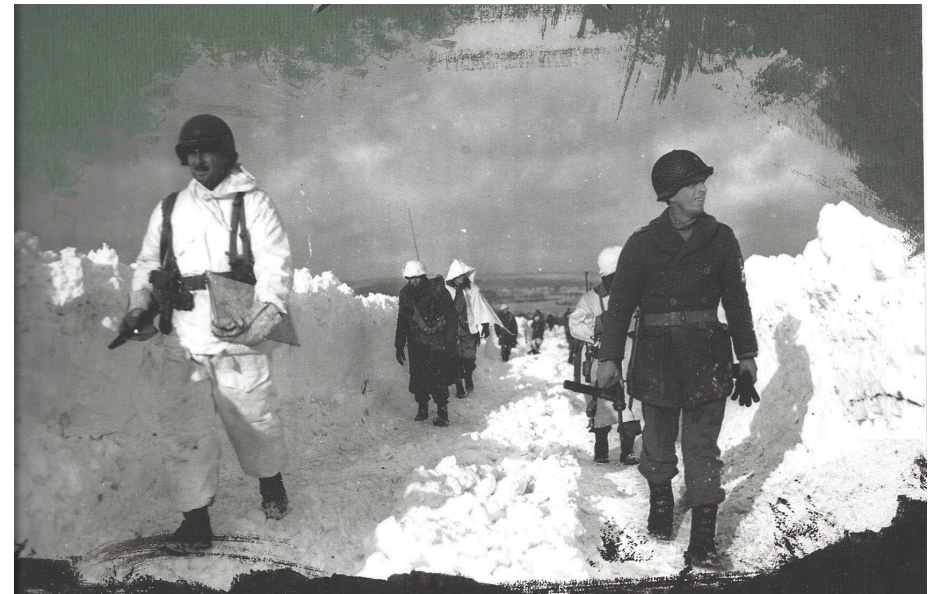

Battle of the Bulge – In Depth With Bob Kozlowski

September 5 to 13, 2026



By September 1944 Allied forces in Western Europe were nearing the German border. An attempt to gain an early crossing of the Rhine at Arnhem had failed with operation Market Garden. In December, the Allies were poised to cross the Rhine, the last great natural barrier to the heart of Germany. In the meantime, Hitler was planning a counter offensive through the Ardennes region of Northern Europe.

This became known as the “Battle of the Bulge”.

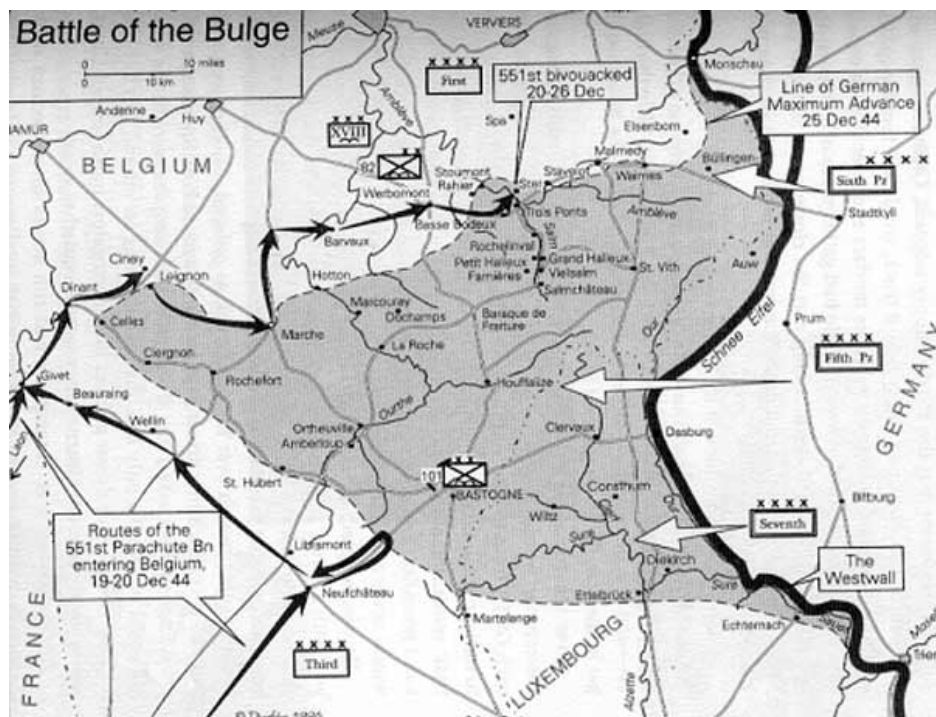
The Ardennes, the historically noted area of “The Battle of the Bulge”, is a geographically beautiful area comprised of hills, rivers and forests. Its is here where much history was made that we remember today. There was much more to this battle than just Bastogne.

This will be a lively-paced tour that will closely re-trace the paths of 1st SS Peiper and the 5th Panzer Army lead by Monteuffel. We will be

crisscrossing their paths and follow the advances into the area eventually nicknamed the “Bulge”. Stopping at many of the memorials, museums and travelling the roads, crossing the bridges and being in the forests where the combat occurred, this tour will bring you to the locations where history was made. We will travel over 400 miles to reach a thorough appreciation of this moment in history.

Reservations and Final Payment

Reservations can only be held with a deposit of \$600 per person per tour, accompanied by the Application form. Valor Tours Ltd. accepts checks and credit cards. Once received a confirmation/invoice, reading list and travel insurance information will be sent to you. Final payment is due 90 days prior to departure unless otherwise stated on confirmation. Reservations will be accepted on a first come – first served basis. Valor Tours, Ltd. does not recommend that children under the age of 12 participate on this tour. Passport required. For US citizens, travel to Europe generally doesn't require a visa for stays less than 90 days. However

Starting in 2026, a new pre-travel authorization called ETIAS will be required for US citizens visiting 30 European countries, including those in the Schengen area. ETIAS is not a visa but rather an electronic authorization that needs to be applied for online before travel. Minimal cost.

Cancellations and Changes

If Valor Tours, Ltd. receives cancellation more than 90 days prior to departure your deposit is fully refundable. Cancellations received between 89 to 30 days prior to commencement of tour subject to loss of deposit. Cancellation within 30 days or 'no shows' are non refundable. Refunds may take up to 30 days to process. Cancellation charges also apply to additional travel arrangements such as airfare. Travel medical emergency, baggage loss/delay and cancellation insurance coverage is available upon request.

Baggage allowance

We recommend one suitcase and one carry-on bag per person, please. Porterage for one bag per person is included in the tour cost; however there may be times when you will be responsible for your baggage, so it is to the benefit of the passenger to travel light. Passengers are responsible for carry-on bags, purses, camera bags, briefcases, etc. No responsibility is accepted for loss or damage to baggage, or any of the passenger's belongings.

Disabilities

Any personal disability requiring special attention should be reported to Valor Tours at the time of reservation. Itinerary – subject to change

Saturday September 5 (D)

Arrival Luxembourg City. Welcome dinner and introductions. Overnight Hotel Cravat (where General Bradley stayed) in Luxembourg.

Sunday September 6 (B)

Depart for Echternach (most southern city considered in the "Bulge") to tour areas along the Saar River to Heosdorf Plateau and Wallendorf to see GI tree carvings, German Westwall, bunkers and sites of infantry action. On to Diekirch for lunch and visit to the museum. Then onto Clervaux, site of 28th Infantry action. Overnight Hotel International, Clervaux.

Monday September 7 (B)

Depart Clervaux for St. Vith to see the tower. From St. Vith we drive through Poteau to see the crossroads named "Dante's Inferno". Then to Losheim to follow Peiper's advance going through the Losheim Gap, Lanzerath, Krinkelt, Rocherath, Elsenborn. Visit Henri-Chapelle American Cemetery and Memorial. Eupen for two nights at the Hotel Ambassador.

Tuesday September 8 (B)

Leave for Hurtgen Forest with our local historian guide; visit to Monschau (northern most city considered in the "Bulge") and extensive visit to the Hurtgen Forest. Have dinner in Monschau, and then back to Eupen. Overnight at The Ambassador.

Wednesday September 9 (B)

Depart Eupen to continue the Peiper route to Stavelot, Trois-Ponts, La Gleize (museum stop), Cheneaux and Werbormont. On the way to Bastogne stop in "Parkers Crossroads", Manhay, Malmedy (massacre sight) and Houffalize to see the tanks and memorials. Reaching Bastogne, check into the Hotel Melba in Bastogne for two nights.

Thursday September 10 (B)

All day touring 101st Airborne battle engagement sites with local guide, ending with a visit to the Bastogne War Museum.

Friday September 11 (B)

Depart Bastogne and follow the path of the 2nd Panzers. The roads will take us to Samree, Dochamps, Hotton, La Roche, Verdenne, Marche, stopping at the Memorials and action sites. Rochefort to Celles (farthest Panzer penetration). Leave for Dinant on the Meuse and the Citadel (great views). Stop at location of The Rock that symbolizes farthest German recon advance in the Bulge offense. Check into Ibis City Centre in Dinant.

Saturday September 12 (B, D)

From Dinant to St. Hubert to see plaques dedicated to French paratroopers, U.S. 87th Inf. Division and one dedicated to Ernest Hemingway who stayed in St. Hubert in December 1944. Onto Luxembourg City for a lunch stop and visit to the American Cemetery and Patton's Grave in Hamm. Stop at Bock Casemates castle and scenic area. Farewell Dinner and overnight Hotel Cravat in Luxembourg.

Sunday September 13 (B)

After breakfast, check out of hotel and transfer to airport. Tour ends.
