





Eighty five years ago, in December 1941, the United States was pulled into the largest and most destructive war in human history. In the end, the allies triumphed over the fascism of Germany, Italy and Japan. The latter nation, by attacking the American Pacific Fleet at Pearl Harbor on December 7th, ensured a titanic struggle for mastery of the vast ocean and its periphery would be waged to the end.

This will be the last major opportunity to mingle with veterans of the Greatest Generation, especially those who are Pearl Harbor survivors (an 18-year old in December 1941 will be 103 today, while one from 1945 will be 99!). This Pearl Harbor guided tour will take us to the island of Oahu in Hawaii to examine the beginnings of America's involvement in the great struggle. We will visit two ships, lying end-to-end, that encapsulate the war – the USS *Arizona*, under its memorial, where the war began that terrible Sunday morning, and the USS *Missouri*, on whose decks the allies accepted complete Japanese surrender on September 2, 1945. We will also see numerous other sites of the war, from ships, submarines and aircraft to Army garrisons and mountain observation points. We will attend several significant WWII remembrance events throughout the week and incorporate them into the itinerary as the schedule is announced.

In addition to the Pearl Harbor tour, we will also visit many places associated with Hawaiian history from its founding as a kingdom under Kamehameha through American whaling and missionary arrivals and on to the US agricultural and financial interests that led to the overthrow of the monarchy in 1893 and the annexation of Hawaii as a US territory in 1898. The incredible story of this civilizational intersection will unfold as we visit critical sites.

Finally, no visit to this beautiful, sun-splashed island would be complete without visits to its gorgeous beaches and small towns for optional snorkeling, swimming, diving, hiking, golfing and just relaxing. From our spectacular Waikiki beachfront base at the beautiful and historic Moana Surfrider Hotel, we will spend a week in paradise and come away far richer for the experience!

The itinerary remains subject to minor change as the 85th Commemoration committee has not yet announced initial activities and celebrations. We will continue to add events to the itinerary as they become available. We expect commemorations at numerous military sites, including Schofield Barracks and Wheeler Army Airfield in addition to the national commemoration on the 7th at Pearl Harbor's Kilo Pier.

Reservations & Cancellations

A reservation can only be held with a deposit of \$1000 per person and on a first come-first served basis. Please fill out, sign and return the application form with your check or credit card number. Final payment is due 60 days prior to tour departure. A reminder with newsletter will be sent to all participants on deposit along with reading list and travel insurance info. Cancellations received up to 60 days prior to tour departure are fully refundable; cancellations received within 60 days of tour commencement non refundable.

Reservation deadline is 30 days prior to tour departure – subject to space availability. Late bookings can be accepted provided space is available and full payment is received immediately. Cost is based on a minimum of 10 passengers traveling together. Unused components of the tour are non-refundable. Tour itinerary and costs subject to change. We do not recommend participation by children under the age of 12 years. Refunds can take up to 60 days to process.

Itinerary – subject to change

December 2 Wednesday

Arrive Honolulu and make your way to the Moana Surfrider Hotel. Check-in at the historic Moana Surfrider on the beach, the first lady of Waikiki, within walking distance of Honolulu's most beloved shopping, dining and entertainment attractions. Social hour on the Verandah at sunset. Group dinner at 6pm with overview of the weeks' events.

December 3 Thursday

After breakfast, visit Pali Heights to discuss the 1790's island unification under King Kamehameha I and the battle of Pali Cliffs where the king's Big Island warriors defeated the Oahu defenders in May 1975. Visit Queen Emma's Summer Palace, the royal family of ease in Victorian splendor. In the hills above Honolulu, halfway to the mountain heights. Visit Iolani Palace, America's only royal Palace. Lunch in downtown Honolulu. Walking tour of Historical Honolulu including Chinatown, the old port and scenes from *From Here to Eternity*. Social hour at hotel at sunset. Dinner on own.

December 4 Friday

Drive to Camp Smith, active USMC base and home of the joint Indo-Pacific Command HQ. Discuss the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor December 7th at the Officer's Club with views of Pearl Harbor and breakfast buffet. Visit the Pearl Harbor Visitor's Center at the WWII Valor in the Pacific National Monument, Arizona Memorial, USS Bowfin submarine, USS Missouri battleship, Pacific Aviation Museum at Ford Island Airfield. Lunch on own on Ford Island. Afternoon visit



the Defense POW/MIA Accounting Agency (DPAA) on Hickam Air Force Base (this is a private tour for our group only). Social hour at sunset at hotel. Dinner on own.

December 5 Saturday

Breakfast at hotel. Head to Schofield Barracks, icon of the US Army from WWII to present; Wheeler Army Air Field; Dole Plantation; lunch on own at the National historic district of quant Haleiwa, famous for it's shaved ice. Afternoon return to Honolulu to visit the National Cemetery of the Pacific at Punchbowl. Return to hotel. Dinner on own.

December 6 Sunday

Breakfast at hotel. Day free to enjoy the beach, golf or go whale-watching. Optional visit to Hanauma Bay to snorkel or hike to the summit of Diamond Head Crater. Or take a stroll over to Fort DeRussy Museum in the heart of Waikiki. Social hour at sunset. Dinner on own.

December 7 Monday

Official 85th Anniversary Ceremonies
Breakfast at hotel. Attend the National Remembrance Ceremonies at Kilo pier with veterans and other survivors and dignitaries. Return and lunch on own in Honolulu. Afternoon attend other commemorative events as available. Evening parade on Waikiki's main boulevard. Group dinner at Duke's on Waikiki, named for the famed Olympian and Hawaiian personality Duke Kahanamoku.

December 8 Tuesday

Breakfast at hotel. Tour ends.
